

Converting WMAs to MP3s or WAVs on a Macintosh Computer [Also available for Windows users]

If you are a Mac user and recorded or downloaded a file that is a WMA file (Windows Media Audio file), you may download a converter program to access the audio file on your Mac. If you need to add an audio file to Blackboard, wma may not be the acceptable audio format.

NOTE*** this application is only for your computer. The Interactive Media Center uses other software that readily performs this function. Switch Audio File Converter converts a variety of different audio file formats including wav, mp3, ogg, aac, wma, au, etc. into mp3 or wav.

Select Download Switch Audio File Converter for Mac Intel (or PPC) from the bottom of the page.

1. Drag and drop selected files. Or select Add File(s) and browse. Add audio file to the middle of the user interface.
2. Specify output folder and format. Usb drives are available to borrow at the Interactive Media Center service desk.
3. Select convert.
