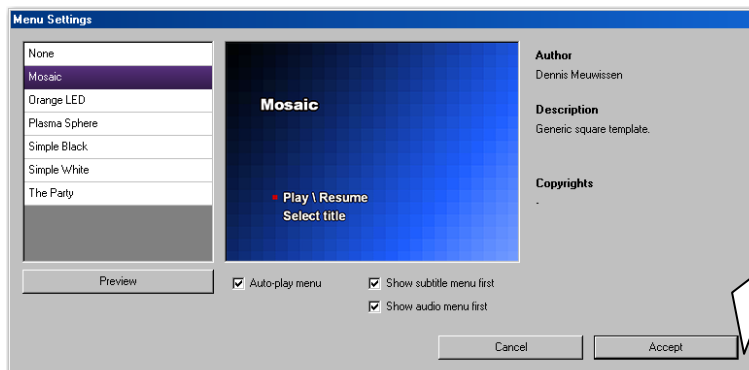
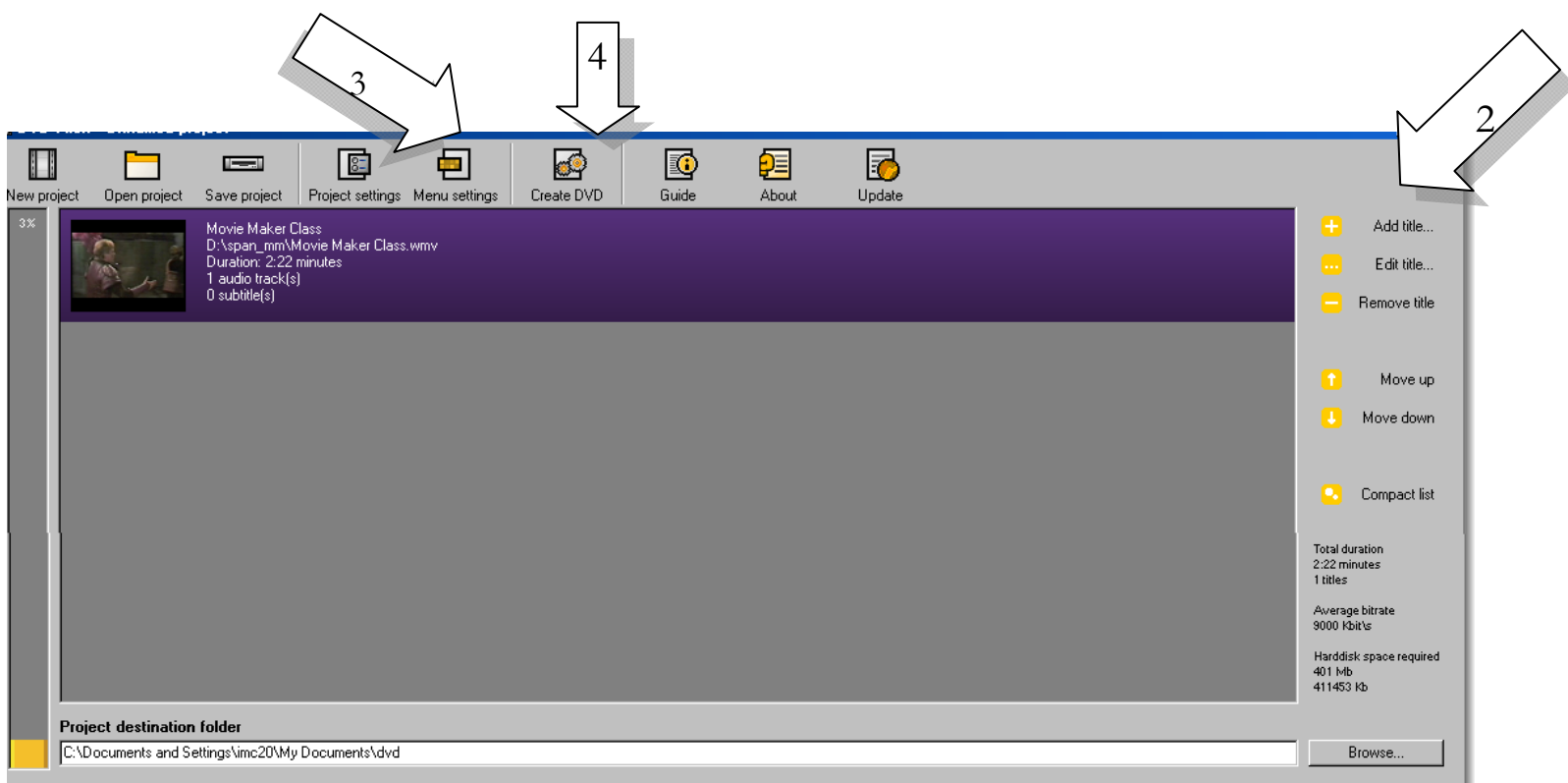


Create a DVD with DVD Flick

DVD Flick may be downloaded from <http://www.dvdflick.net/> (open source application, accessed 06/02/10). NOTE: This application will not create a DVD format from WMV files generated by Microsoft PhotoStory 3. **BEFORE step 5, turn page to check settings.**

1. Open **DVD Flick** from the Start Menu.
2. Click the **Add Title** button and browse for a video file to add. Continue adding files, until the yellow bar on the left-hand side of the program window indicates the disc is full. Select **Edit Title** if you want to create chapters to allow the viewer to advance directly to particular scenes in the movie(s).
3. To create a menu to play a title from a list select **Menu Settings**.
4. Click the **Create DVD** button to have your DVD created and burned.



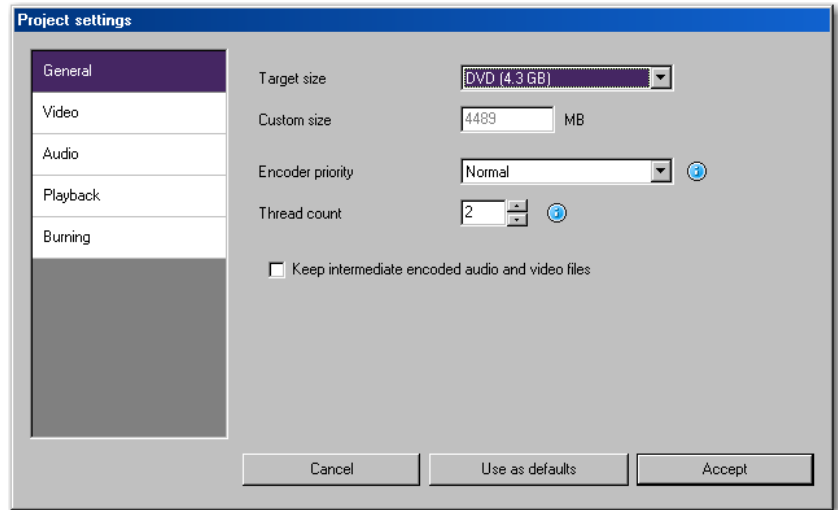
Menu settings:

- Select a menu if you have scene selections to view only portions of your movie or to select specific movies to view if more than one are added to the DVD.

Select Project Settings from the menu and review as per below:

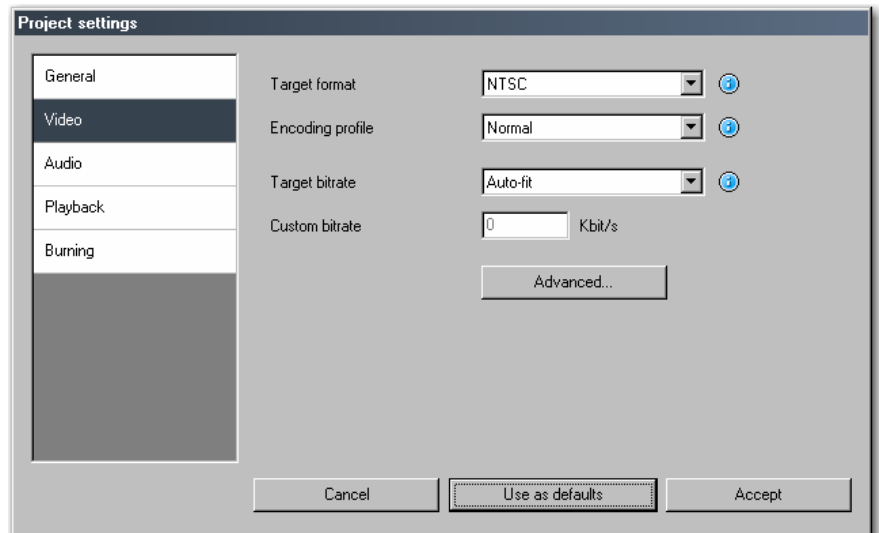
General:

- See settings in diagram. You may select CD settings also.



Video:

- If your movie will be viewed in the United States, select NTSC for Target format. Select PAL for viewing in some other countries.



Burning to DVD:

- Use DVD-R (most compatible with DVD players). DVD+R are also appropriate for use.
