
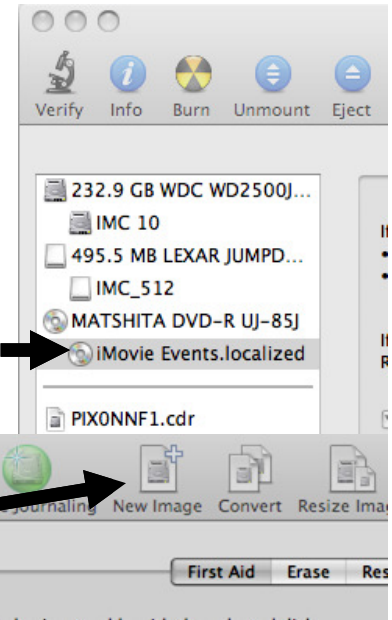


Making Copies of a DVD [and CD] on a Macintosh

Use this guide to quickly copy the contents of a DVD onto another DVD on a **Macintosh computer**. DVD-R is the most compatible type of DVD for DVD movies. DVDs and CDs may be purchased at the Circulation desk, first floor. This guide assumes that the contents are not encrypted—the DVD or CD contents are not copyright protected or commercially produced.

1. Click on the **Apple menu** () in the upper left-hand corner of the screen, and choose **Accessories**, then **Disk Utility**.
2. Insert the original DVD into the drive, with the label side facing you.
3. Select the DVD from the list on the left-hand side of the Disk Utility when it appears.
4. Click the **New Image** button. In the window that appears:
 - a. Choose to save your disk copy to the **IMC Public** folder.
 - b. **IMPORTANT:** Be sure to select **DVD/CD Master** for the **Image Format**!
 - c. Select **none** for Encryption.



5. Remove the DVD from the drive and insert the blank DVD, with the label side facing you just like before.
6. Click the **Burn** button.
The DVD will eject when complete.
