



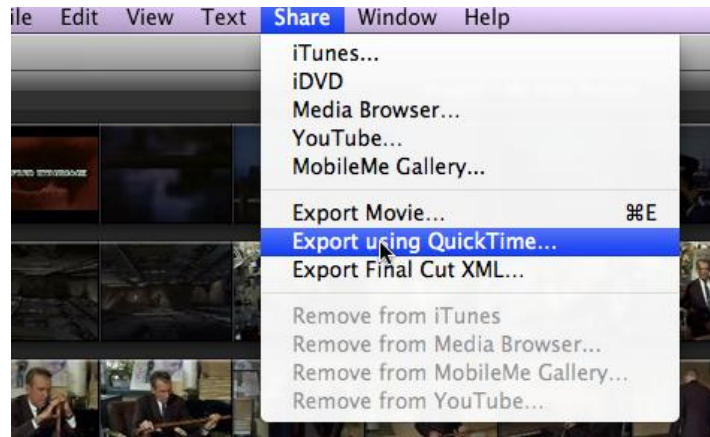
## Quick tips: Using iMovie '09 to create a WMV file (Windows Media Video) & burn to CD-R

This handout begins after you have completed the editing portion of your video. Follow the steps to make your iMovie project play with Windows Media Player. **NOTE!!!!** The Interactive Media Center purchased Flip4Mac WMV Studio and Quick Time Pro to encode your movie as a WMV file. For your Macintosh machine, the IMC recommends that you download and use the free Windows Media Player, Flip4Mac, to *play* Windows Media files in QuickTime Player:

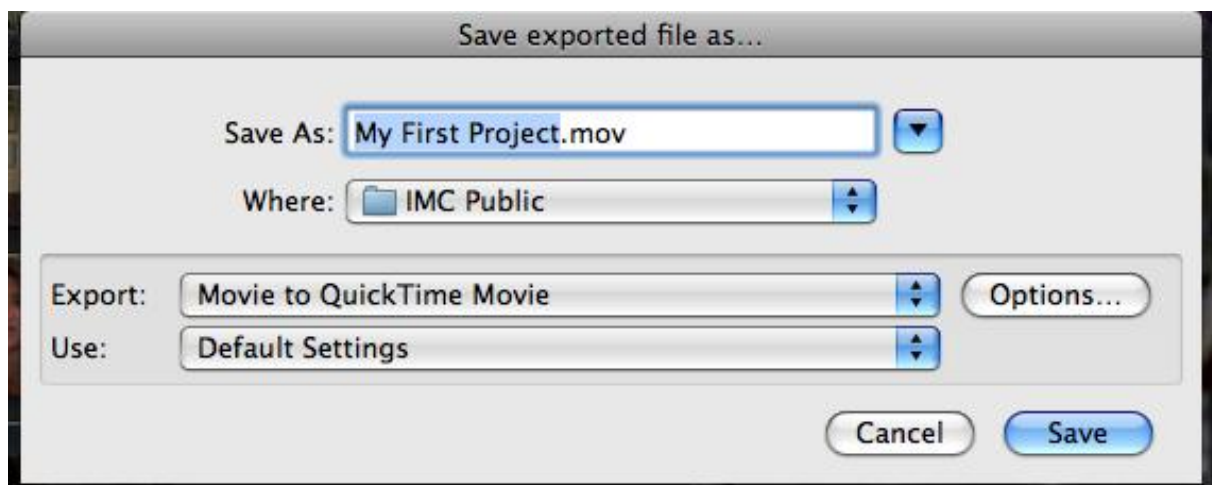

CD-Rs are available for purchase at the Circulation desk on the first floor.

1. Select **Share > Export using QuickTime**

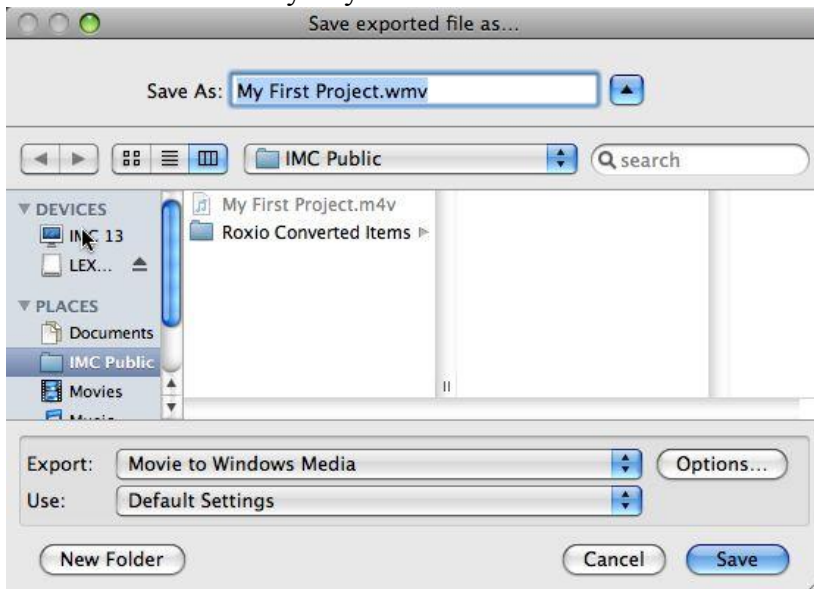


2. Name your file and save it in the **IMC PUBLIC** folder. Select **Save**. You will create a .mov QuickTime video file.

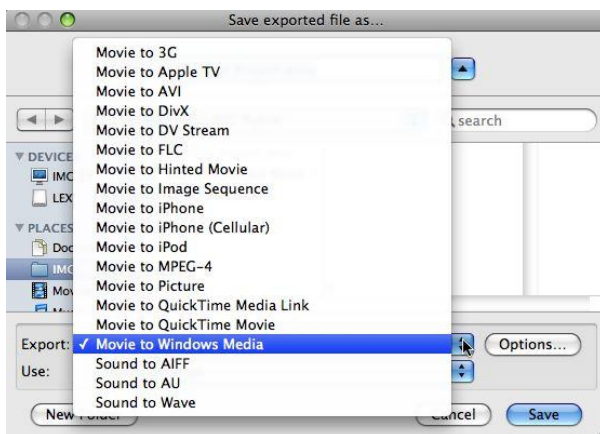




- Exit iMovie when the export is complete. Open **QuickTime Pro**. From the Apple menu, select **Programs > Video > QuickTime Pro**. Open the .mov file you just created.
- Select **File > Export**. Select the IMC Public folder if you intend to burn the video to a CD. You can also save it directly to your USB drive.



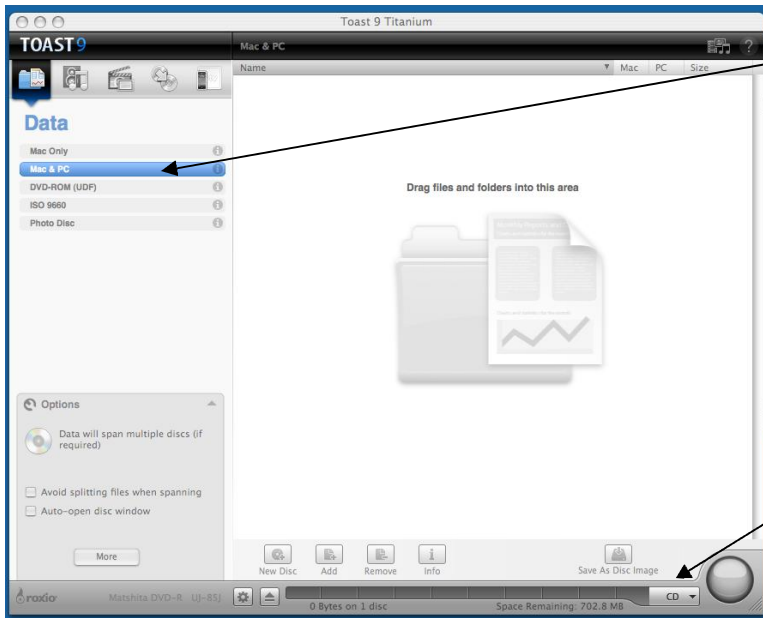
Select **Movie to Windows Media (WMV)**. If the export does not default to Movie to Windows Media, press the drop down arrow and select as per below: Select **Save**



### Steps to place the WMV file (Windows Media Video) on CD-R

To put the movie onto a CD-R, you cannot save to a CD-R. After you have created the wmv file on the hard drive or usb drive, “burn” the WMV file to CD-R using Roxio Toast.

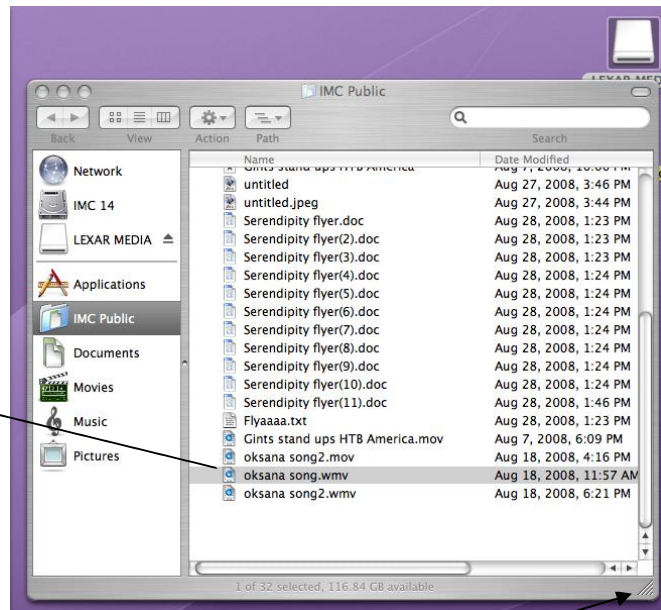
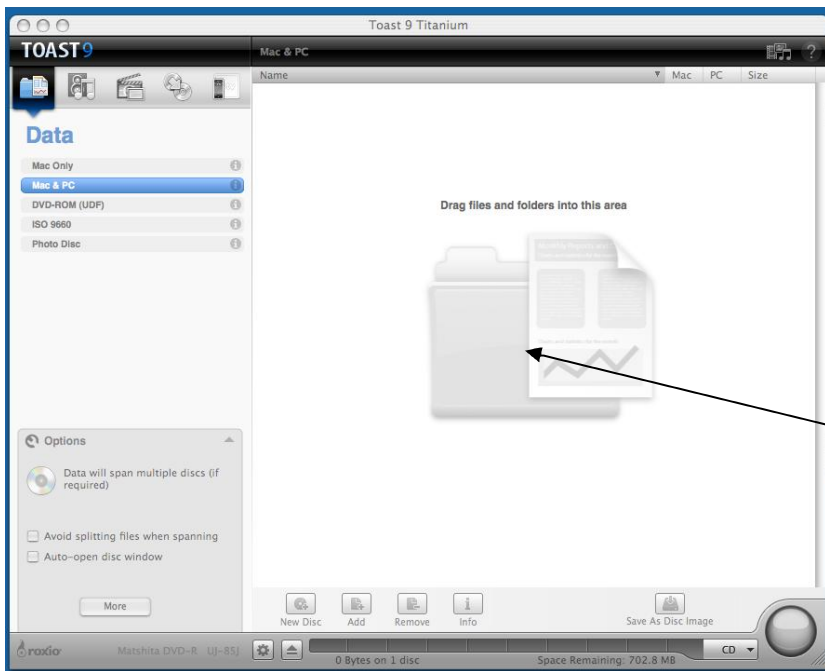
- Exit from QuickTime Pro
- From the Apple menu,  select **Programs > Accessories > Toast Titanium**
- Insert a blank CD-R



4. Select **Data: Mac & PC** (You already encoded your movie so do not select Video)

Select **CD**

5. Find your .wmv file and drag it onto Toast.



You may need to shrink the Roxio Toast Window in order to display both windows. Drag the bottom right corner to the left and reposition the window.



6. Select **Burn** by pressing the button. When complete your CD will eject.
