

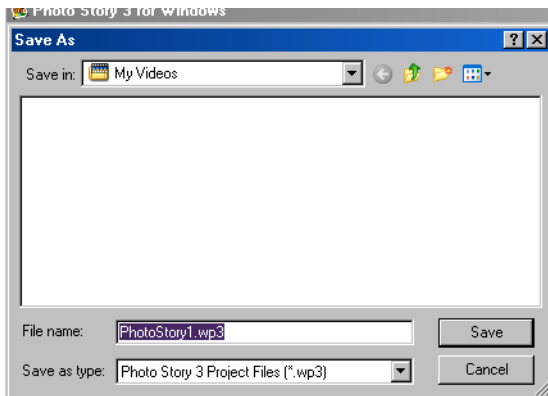
## Quick tips: Using Photo Story 3 to create an audio slideshow to play with Window Media Player & burn to CD-R

Photo Story 3, it is available on the Windows computers and free to download to your Windows computer from the Microsoft website: <http://www.microsoft.com/> It is not available for Macs; use iMovie. When you've completed your slideshow and are ready to create a Windows Media file (.WMV) follow these steps to make your Photo Story project play with Windows Media Player.

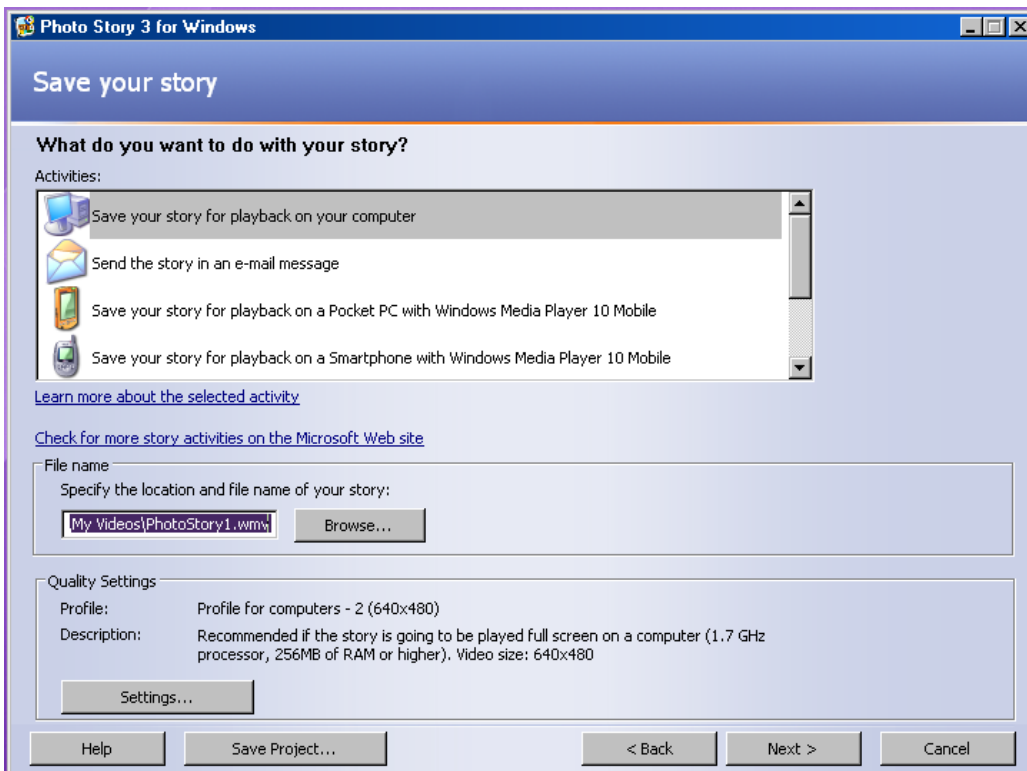
CD-Rs are available for purchase at the Circulation desk on the first floor.

### Steps to create a WMV file (Windows Media)



Save your project one more time. Note that it creates a .wp3 file. This is a Photo Story 3 *working* project file. You cannot share it outside of Photo Story until you create a Windows Media file.

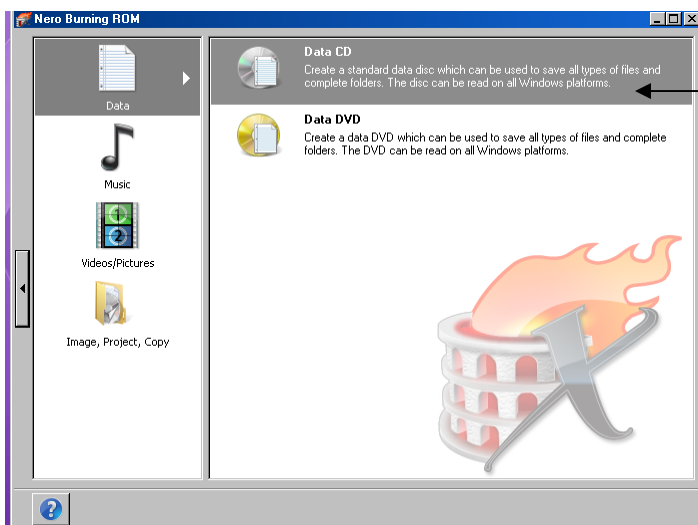
The last step in the Photo Story project is **Save your story**. For most projects and for burning to CD-R you will select **Save your story for playback on your computer**. To put the movie onto a CD-R, you cannot save to a CD-R. Browse to save your WMV file to the My Documents folder or your USB drive.



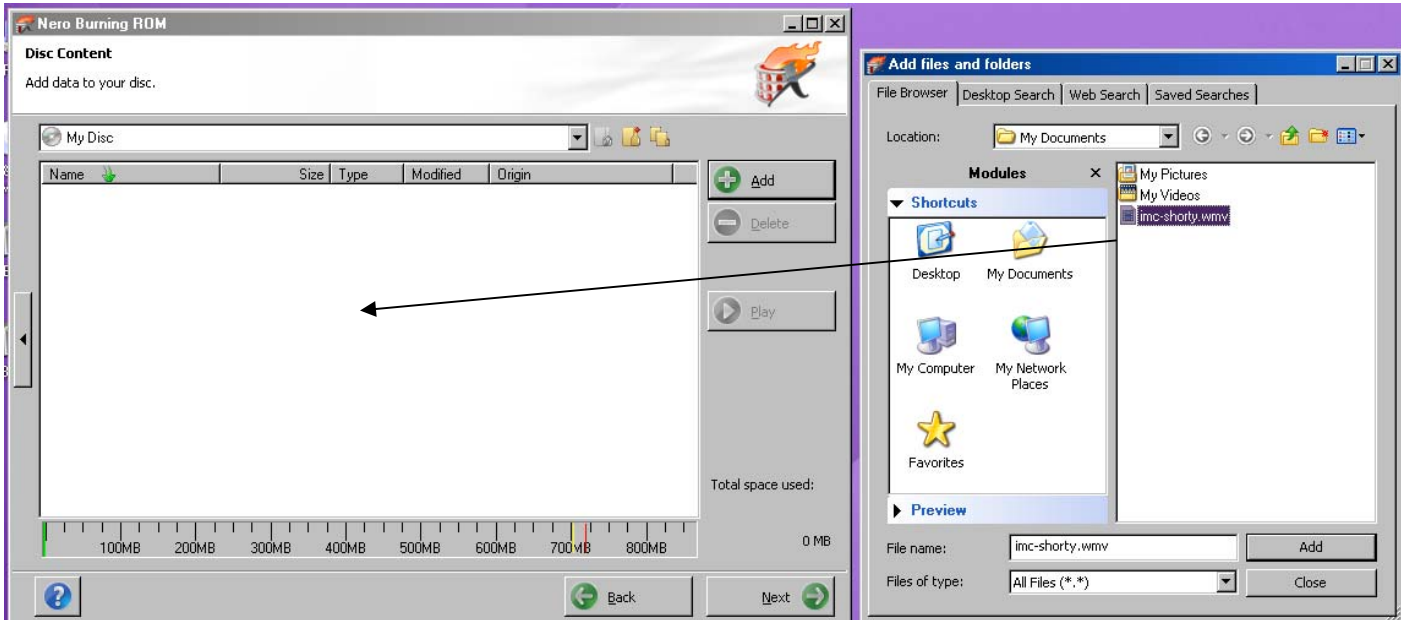
## Steps to place the WMV file (Windows Media Video) on CD-R

After you saved your wmv file to the hard drive or usb drive, “burn” the WMV file to CD-R using Nero in the Interactive Media Center.

1. Exit from Photo Story after your WMV file is created
2. From the Start menu select **Programs > Nero Express** and insert a blank CD-R. Be sure **CD-ROM (ISO)** is selected and **No Multisession**.
3. Select **Nero Express**

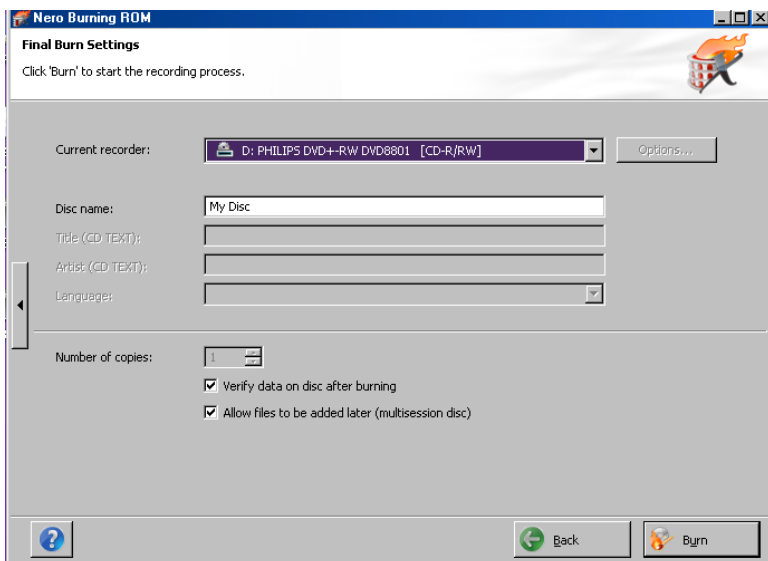


4. Select **Data CD**



5. Select **Add** and drag and drop your file into the Nero Window

Select **Next**



6. Select **Burn**
