The Edison Club

The historic Edison Club is located on Riverview Road (County Route 91) in Rexford, NY. The Club was founded in 1904 as a social club by GE employees and is the home of one of the Capital Region's finest golf courses.

DIRECTIONS



From Albany: Take the Northway (I87) North to Exit 8A. Turn left onto Grooms Road. Stay on Grooms Road until it merges with Riverview Road. Merge Right onto Riverview Road. Take Riverview for about 1 mile. The Clubhouse will be on your right.

From Schenectady: Take Route 146 (Balltown Road) North to Rexford. Cross the Rexford Bridge. At the light (Stewarts) take a right onto Riverview Road. The clubhouse is approximately ¼ mile on your left.

From Saratoga: Take the Northway (I87) South to Exit 9. Follow Route 146 approximately 6 miles. Turn Left at the Four-way traffic light. Go to The next light (Stewarts) and take a left onto Riverview Road. The Clubhouse is approximately ¼ mile on your left.

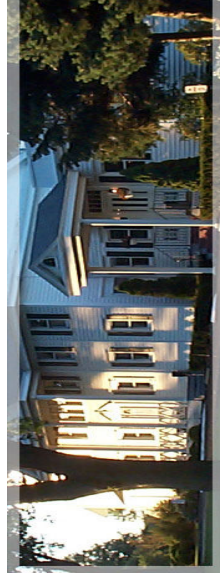
