Getting Started

Keywords are terms considered to be “key” to finding information. **You might find them useful for your catalog and database searches.** Some examples:

- Testimonio, novela-testimonio, testimony, testimonial (discourse, narrative, novel, texts, writing...), testimonials, documentary narrative...
- Subalternidad, subalterno, subaltern (studies, representation, subject...)
- Memoria, olvido, desmemoria, memory, oblivion...
- Voices of the voiceless, Los sin voz, La voz de los sin voz, unheard voices...
- Margins of literature, marginal, margin...
- Testigo, witness, witnessing...

It is a worldwide union catalog created and maintained collectively by more than 9,000 member institutions. Most of the US academic libraries are represented in this catalog.

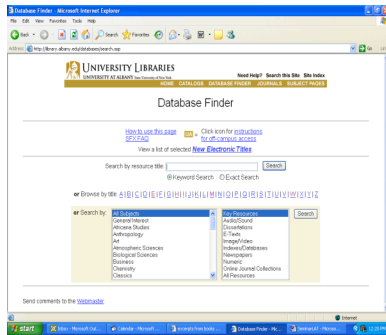

MLA International Bibliography

Coverage: 1963-

Fulltext? Provides links to some full-text articles and allows access to full-text articles to subscribed journals.

Description: Consists of bibliographic records pertaining to literature, language, linguistics, and folklore. It draws on scholarly research in over 3,000 journals and series, covering relevant monographs, working papers, proceedings, bibliographies and other formats.

Hispanic American Periodicals Index (HAPI)

Coverage: 1970-

Fulltext? You can limit your searches to citations to full-text only. Links would take you to either journals the library subscribes to or to freely available articles on the web.

Description: Provides access to bibliographic information of scholarly articles and book reviews from key journals worldwide primarily on Latin American and U.S. Latino topics.

Coverage: 1935-

Fulltext? No

Description: A bibliography on Latin America consisting of works selected and annotated by scholars and edited by the Hispanic Division of the Library of Congress. Each year, more than 130 academics from around the world choose over 5,000 works for inclusion in the Handbook.
