### Reference Source

*Purpose:* Gives you a brief overview of your topic.

*Use:* The Reference Universe Database or ask a Reference librarian for help!

#### Tip:

The bibliography at the back of a book or at the end of an article can help you find more sources for your topic!



### Book

*Purpose:* Gives you more in-depth information about your topic.

*Use:* Minerva, the online catalog.

# How to Locate Information on your Research Topic

#### Tip:

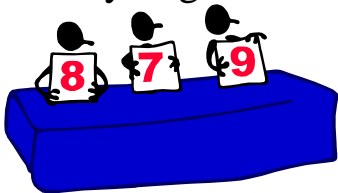
Use the subject headings link on an item's record in Minerva to find more items on that subject!



### Research by Subject link

*Purpose:* Guides created by subject librarians to help you find internet sources and research guides on your topic.

### Evaluate your sources as you go!



### Article

*Purpose:* Gives you more current information on your topic.

*Use:* A subject-specific database or a general database, like EBSCO Academic Search Complete.
