Library Hours Task Force Report

March 1, 2017

Task Force Members: Carol Anderson, Gerry Burke, Irina Holden, Peter Recore-Migirditch (Chair), Kabel Stanwicks, and Lindsay Van Berkom

Charge

The Library Hours Task Force was charged with the following:

- Provide suggestions for changes to the library hours, schedule of services and staffing levels at various times when the library is open
- Consider patron safety and security, typical use and available staffing or funding for more staff
- Examine data on the use of both the facilities and the services in all three libraries
- Review the library facilities with an eye toward opening sections of the library rather than the whole facility
- Provide recommendations for levels of staffing and security during hours of operation
- Provide a final report which will include recommendations on optimal library hours for all three libraries as well as estimated dollar amount necessary to put these hours into practice

Introduction/Background

Library hours are frequently commented upon whenever input on library services is solicited from the students and faculty. Complaints and suggestions are varied depending on the affiliation of the respondent and are difficult to quantify. In addition, most of the input received focuses on the hours of the University Library and it is difficult to determine if the hours at the Dewey and Science Libraries are meeting the needs of users. Complaints are often heard from students that the library does not open early enough. Recently, graduate students have asked for the libraries to be open on weekends during intersessions. The members of the Student Advisory board have also raised questions on the hours of operation. There have also been requests across the years to provide 24/7 study space.

The purpose of this task force is to evaluate the current operating hours of all three libraries to determine if they effectively meet the needs of the students and faculty. To obtain input from the university community regarding the operating hours the task force developed a comprehensive survey to be administered to the target audience. Considering the length of time it was going to take to develop the survey and have it approved by the campus the task force decided to conduct a Twitter Chat on April 20, 2016 to obtain student input. Participation in the Twitter Chat was very low and the input received basically confirmed what was already known about the operating hours.

Coordinated through the Office of Institutional Research, Planning, & Effectiveness a campus survey of library hours was developed and used to obtain input from as many students and faculty as possible. On October 26, 2016 the survey was sent to 5793 individuals and 1351 people responded; a response rate of 23.32%. A total of 803 responses were from undergraduate and graduate students and 548 faculty/staff responded. See Appendix A "Library Hours Survey Results" and Appendix B "Library Hours Survey Results Summary".

The survey confirmed many of the observations and experiences noted by the Access Services and Dewey staff managing service points (see the section on "Current Building Use & Trends"). Survey respondents overwhelmingly preferred to use the University Library. For all three libraries the respondents preferred to use the facilities during the hours of noon – 9pm on any given day. Approximately 20% of the users who come during the week come on the weekends and 28%

indicated they would not use a 24 hour space. 81% of the respondents felt the winter intersession hours were adequate, 75% felt the same about summer intersession hours, and 56% did not find it inconvenient that the library is closed on weekends during intersessions. Respondents used the library predominately for: quiet study (59%), ability to connect to Wi-Fi (47%), collaborative study (39%), and printing (36%). When asked to provide input as to what additional hours they would like 45% of the respondents skipped the question. Although the response rates were low respondents did indicate the desire for later closing times on Sundays for all three libraries.

In addition peer institutions were contacted to obtain information regarding operating hours of their libraries. Task force members contacted and interviewed the following institutions: SUNY Centers at Binghamton, Buffalo, Stony Brook; ARL "near peers" Universities of Southern Illinois, Auburn, California Riverside, Ohio; and ARL aspirational Universities of Delaware, Massachusetts, and Connecticut. Information was documented regarding operating hours during "regular" weekends, spring break, intersession, summer, extended hours during final exams, and 24 hour facilities. See the section on "Peer Institutions Comparison" and Appendix C "Library Hours: SUNY Centers, "near peers" and aspirational peers".

The task force also investigated the availability of study space on campus and found that the Campus Center, Business School, and Residential Life were the only departments that provided study space. These opportunities are very limited in availability, selective in who can use the space, and offer very limited technology in the available space. See the section on "Campus Resources for Study Space".

During the 2016 summer intersessions, summer session, and fall semester, Access Services and Dewey Library performed floor counts which noted user activities and space use in all three libraries. Student Assistants walked through each building during weekday hours, weekend hours, after opening, and before closing and counted the number of users observed. The three libraries have conducted observational studies of users in the buildings by walking through the buildings and taking head counts and noting the activities taking place such as independent study, group study, PC use, and social interactions in the past, which is why this approach was chosen for data gathering for this study. The University & Science Library use gate counters that will provide the number of users that enter/exit the building but these data do not reliably quantify the number of users in a given building because the gate counters do not provide directional data. This data was used to answer questions related to building use by observation as well as assess the input received in the hours survey sent to the university community. See the section on "Current Building Use & Trends".

Recommendations & Considerations

Overall the data indicates that the current library hours meet most users' needs. There are cases where it may be useful to pilot some expansion of hours to see if these changes should be factored into the operating hours.

The task force recommends the following:

A. Academic Semester Hours

University Library: No changes in the hours of operation are needed during academic semesters. Based on statistics collected through Library observational counts (see the section on "Current Building Use & Trends") and survey responses, the current hours satisfy a great percentage of users.

Science Library: No recommendations at this time. Based on the data collected, current academic semester hours are adequate.

Dewey Library: It is suggested that a pilot study be conducted to allow Dewey to remain open later on Sundays during the academic semester. This could be accomplished by expanding the closing hours or shifting the operating hours by opening the library later and closing later. Shifting hours would allow for maintaining current staffing levels without negatively impacting users. Expanding the hours would necessitate additional staff resources. Observational studies (see the section on "Current Building Use & Trends") indicate there are few users in the Dewey Library during early Sunday hours of operation but the average number of users in the Dewey Library prior to closing exceeded the overall daily average of users. Respondents to the Library Hours Survey indicated Sunday 4pm – 9pm is a very desirable time.

Observational Studies: The University and Science Libraries did not see large numbers of users immediately after opening or immediately prior to closing at any time. Peak usage occurs earlier in the day at each of these libraries and is extremely low around opening and closing times. These findings were mostly true for Dewey as well, except for on Sundays. The data show that Sundays have the highest average number of people in the building and a peak usage near the current closing time.

Hours Survey: Respondents were asked to provide input on what additional hours they would like implemented and 45% of the respondents skipped the question. Fewer than 20% indicated they wanted later closing times in general. See Appendix B: Library Survey Results Summary questions Q4, Q9, and Q10.

B. Intersessions

University Library: It is recommend a pilot study be conducted to determine the feasibility of keeping the University Library **open on weekends during winter intersession**. The pilot would allow for the collection of data to determine the level of use staying open on weekends during intersessions. There is no available data to determine if this expansion of hours should be supported. Once the pilot is conducted and observational statistics are available Library administrators can determine the feasibility of expanding these hours. This would have little impact on staffing levels as the staff is currently in place for weekend coverage. Currently when an academic session ends and staff transition to intersession hours they have to adjust their schedules by working Monday – Friday. Staying open on weekends would allow the employees to maintain their regular schedules.

Science Library: No recommendations at this time. Based on the data collected, current intersession hours are adequate.

Dewey Library: It is recommend a pilot study be conducted to allow Dewey to keep the existing days of operation (Monday-Friday), but to expand the hours of operation by remaining open later during the **May intersession**. This change would allow for mostly maintaining current staffing levels without negatively impacting users. Depending on how late the library would remain open during the pilot study, compensating extra hours for a student staff may need to be considered. In general it is recommended to hire two students at minimum wage which would cost \$22/hour. In the hours survey, when asked about weekend hours during intersessions the majority of survey responses (56%) indicated that there was no need to be open weekends during intersessions. 33% of the participants skipped this question and 44% of the remaining respondents indicated they found it inconvenient when closed on weekends

(Appendix B, question Q15). Based on this information we do not recommend including weekends as part of the expanded hours of operations during the pilot study. Another consideration to keep in mind is covering potential staff vacations. May Intersession can be a popular time for staff to take time off. Staying open later could reduce the flexibility available amongst staff schedules in order to cover shifts for evening staff who may desire to take vacation during this time frame.

C. Extended Hours

University Library: Consider staying open on weekends during extended hours to accommodate weekend exams. When there are exams scheduled on Saturday & Sunday it is recommended that the library continues a 24 hour operation on these days. Weekend exams were introduced during the fall 2016 semester with no notification to the University Libraries and it must be investigated to determine if this will be a regular or an infrequent occurrence.

Currently, during extended hours for final exams, UPD has been posting a guard in the University Library Monday – Friday from 11pm until early morning, approximately 7 am. UPD has not charged for this service. According to Aron Mull, Deputy Chief of Police – Operations, if the hours were expanded to remain open 24 hours on weekends they would be able to continue the free service.

There are significant staffing implications in expanding 24 hour services on weekends. None of the current staff can easily shift their hours to cover weekends. It is recommended that a security force is hired to supervise the building along with student assistants. See the sections on "Staffing and Safety & Security Issues".

Science Library: No recommendations at this time. Based on the data collected, current extended hours are adequate.

Dewey Library: No recommendations at this time. Dewey has not offered extended hours in the past and based on the data collected, current hours are adequate during exam periods.

D. Summer Sessions

University Library: No recommendations at this time. Based on the data collected, current summer hours are adequate.

Science Library: No recommendations at this time. Based on the data collected, current summer hours are adequate.

Dewey Library: No recommendations at this time. Based on the data collected, current summer hours are adequate.

E. Study Space for 24/7

It is recommended that the University find an alternate location for this type of space. Utilizing library space is not a cost effective solution in providing this type of space. Implementation of this type of study space (see the section on "24/7 Study Space") within any University Library facility is not recommended for the following reasons.

- 1. Observational data collected shows waning use in the later hours
- 2. The hours survey indicated very low demand for this type of space. See Appendix B: Library Survey Results Summary, question Q11.

- 3. The hours survey also indicates the most desired activities do not require traditional library services; for example, students prefer quiet study and connecting to campus Wi-Fi. These types of activities can be supported by other campus locations besides the University Libraries. See Appendix B, question Q13.
- 4. There are issues related to transportation, parking on campus, bus service, and personal safety.
- 5. Peer institutions, including other SUNY Centers, have buildings that are convenient for providing this type of space without major building modifications. See the section on "Peer Institutions Comparison" and Appendix C "Library Hours: SUNY Centers, "near peers" and aspirational peers". Staffing at SUNY Centers varies but in general most provide 1 to 2 full time employees with a combination of 2 to 3 student assistants. Peer institutions typically had difficulties with staffing and security. Most institutions worked toward providing an optimal amount of services according to their needs and possibilities: taking into consideration architectural limitations, the availability of staffing, and providing a safe environment. The solutions to these issues varied widely from institution to institution.

F. Assessing Future Changes to Library Hours

Any changes in hours should be assessed for effectiveness. Assessment should be done by conducting observational floor counts to collect facility use data with the same methodology used by this task force. Access Services and Dewey Library staff should be charged with this task and then forward findings and recommendations to LPG for final consideration. These observational floor counts should be coordinated well in advance so that adequate staffing can be allocated to complete this task.

G. Facility modifications to accommodate expanded hours

It is recommend that facility modifications should not be pursued to facilitate an expansion of operating hours. The expense involved in modifying the facilities cannot be justified by the low use during late night hours. See the section on "Extended Hours and 24/7 Study Space" for details on building modification requirements. The majority of respondents to the Library Hours Survey indicated (Appendix B: Library Survey Results Summary question Q4) on any given day the heaviest use occurs between noon – 9pm with the period of noon - 4 pm seeing slightly more use than 4pm – 9pm they visit library facilities between noon – 9pm with. Observational studies have also concluded that late night use does not warrant these modifications.

Other Considerations:

<u>How facilities are being used</u>: See "Current Building Use & Trends" and Appendix D "Data Tables from Observational Studies".

1. Hours Survey:

- **Preferred Libraries**: 70% of respondents preferred to use the University Library, 20% preferred Science and 10% preferred Dewey.
- Preferred hours: At all three Libraries the preference for use occurs between noon – 9pm with the period of noon - 4 pm seeing slightly more use than 4pm – 9pm. Less than 25% of the respondents indicated using the library on weekends.
- **Sunday hours**: University and Science Library respondents indicated that Sunday hours of 9pm midnight is a desirable time to use the library; Dewey Library respondents indicated a preference for Sunday 4pm 9pm.

- Preferred Services: 59% of all respondents indicated they came to the library for quite study, 47% for the ability to connect to Wi-Fi, and 39% for collaborative study.
- Intersession hours: 81% of respondents indicated the hours were adequate during Winter intersession and 75% indicated the hours were adequate during Summer intersession.
- Difficulties in accessing libraries: 74% of respondents indicated there were
 no issues preventing them from visiting the library. Open comments for this
 question identified the following difficulties in order of most often cited:
 Inadequate hours, parking difficulties, too much noise, lack of available
 computers and poor Wi-Fi, smokers in the entrance, East Campus travel
 distance, 3 complaints about poor accessibility for disabled.
- Feedback on Intersession hours: 56% of respondents did not feel it was inconvenient that the libraries were closed on weekends. If the libraries were opened on weekends during intersessions 64% indicated they preferred Saturday noon 4 pm, 56% preferred Sunday noon 4 pm, 41% preferred Saturday 4pm 8pm, and 43% preferred Sunday evening 4pm 8pm.
- Comprehensive Exams: survey data is unreliable for making recommendations for comprehensive exams. When the task force researched how departments administer comp exams it was found there is a lot of inconsistency in terms of when comps are scheduled. A recommendation for expanded hours for comp exams cannot be made.

2. Observational Studies:

- Current use: The University and Science Libraries did not see large numbers
 of users immediately after opening or immediately prior to closing at any time.
 Peak usage occurs earlier in the day at each of these libraries and is extremely
 low around opening and closing times. Therefore, the task force found that
 operational hours for the University and Science Libraries are adequate given
 current use and demand.
- Peak usage: Each library saw the heaviest use during the academic semester.
 All three libraries saw the heaviest use in the early evening (i.e., 5:00pm) during
 late-September. The Dewey Library was busiest on Sundays during the fall
 semester; the Science and University Libraries were busiest on Mondays
 during the fall semester; all three libraries see the most use in the late afternoon to early-evening on these days.
- Use of space: The three University Libraries provide a variety of user spaces in each facility and created various noise-level zones at the beginning of the Fall 2015 semester. In examining the building use for each library, the task force determined the spaces and types of activities in which most users engage in each library. In the University Library, the first floor is the most heavily used space, with most users engaged in independent study. In the Science Library, the first floor Information Commons is the most heavily used space, with most users engaged in PC use. In the Dewey Library, the first floor is the most heavily used space, with most users engaged in PC use.
- Opening & closing times: Each library saw the highest use around opening and closing during the fall semester from late-September to early-October.
- Intersession use: Each library saw low usage during the May intersession and heaviest intersession use occurred just prior to the fall semester in each library.

Peer Institutions Comparison

To learn about library services provided by some peer institutions of the University at Albany, several libraries were selected to study their approach to offering library hours and services. See Appendix C, "Library Hours: SUNY Centers, "near peers" and aspirational peers". This included hours of operations during regular semester times and intersessions and extended hours, as well as services offered during regular and extended times. The task force was also interested in 24-hour services offered by the libraries. These libraries included SUNY peer institutions, so-called "near peer" institutions (i.e. those listed in ARL list of high level research institutions right above or below University at Albany ranked 111 in September 2016; and also "aspirational peers" those institutions that are listed above University at Albany in ARL rankings). Selected institutions included the following:

SUNY Centers: University at Buffalo, Binghamton University and Stony Brook University.

"Near peers" (as of September 2016): Southern Illinois University (ranked 109), Auburn University (ranked 110), University of California at Riverside (ranked 112) and Ohio University (ranked 113).

"Aspirational peers": University of Delaware (ranked 82), University of Massachusetts at Amherst (ranked 94), and University of Connecticut (ranked 64).

The SUNY Center libraries listed above were contacted with the questions about the availability of 24/7 space, and also questions about staffing, space in use, security, and services provided. Peer libraries generally were responsive to our requests and provided needed details about hours of operations and their services when classes were in session, including summer. The results are summarized below:

- 1. **24 hour service:** All three SUNY University Centers (Buffalo, Binghamton and Stony Brook) offer 24 hours service in various degrees. University at Buffalo opened a new branch after renovation in August 2016. The Oscar A. Silverman Library in Capen Hall, is open 24/7 when classes are in session, including summer. At Binghamton University, Bartle Library offers 24 hours space Sunday through Friday (Sunday noon Friday 8p.m.). At Stony Brook University, Melville library offers 24 hours space in one of their reading rooms, the Central Reading Room. It is open from Sunday noon until midnight on Thursday for 24 hours, with shorter hours on Fridays (8:30 am -8 pm) and Saturdays (10am 10 pm).
- 2. 24 hour space offered differs among the institutions. Usually it is an enclosed space that has an outside access. For example, at UBuffalo, the Silverman Library occupies two floors of Capen Hall that are open 24 hours. It is achieved by locking the elevators to the top floors. Capen Hall has three more floors, of which one belongs to the Silverman Library but is not open to the public at night. At Binghamton, Bartle Library is open Sunday noon to Thursday midnight. This includes an entire building, which has four floors. At Stony Brook, the Central Reading room is open, and the access to elevators and other floors is blocked by installing the stanchions. Such an arrangement presents difficulties to staff in securing the rest of the building.
- Staffing differs from institution to institution, and also between different times of day. At Buffalo's Silverman library there are two FT employees at day time, including

a circulation supervisor. One evening FT staff works until 12 midnight, and then there is a night FT person that works with two-three student assistants. The students who work at night time are called student monitors (some have background in security). At Binghamton there is 2 professional staff until 11 p.m. After that there are two students, one graduate and one undergraduate, that work in a building. At Stony Brook, there is two staff members present at night, between 12 midnight and 8 a.m.

- 4. **Computers and Wi-Fi access** are usually provided. At Buffalo there is no technical assistance offered between midnight and 8 a.m. At Stony Brook there is an IT staff member available at night. At Binghamton the computer consultants are available until 2 a.m.
- Security services are usually not employed although one of Buffalo's student assistants has a background in security. Mostly the libraries have to rely on police help with monitoring the space, although no institution seems to secure police presence at all times.
- 6. **Lending services** are either limited or not provided. For example, at Buffalo there are no circulation services available between midnight and 8 a.m. At Binghamton the circulation services close at 2 a.m. At Stony Brook the services are limited to checking-in materials and assisting patrons with online payments of fines.
- 7. **Group study spaces** are usually open and available to students. For example, Silverman Library at Buffalo is a multimedia library with 17 group study rooms for multimedia purposes. At Binghamton group study rooms are open at all times with the exception of one hour per night for cleaning. At Stony Brook there are also group study rooms available at the Central Reading Room.

Non-SUNY peer institutions

Among the selected institutions some of the libraries offer 24-hour space. For example, Auburn University's Ralph Brown Draughon Library is open at all times when classes are in session. University of Massachusetts at Amherst Du Bois library offers 24-hour space from Sunday 11 am till Friday 9 pm. Ohio University Libraries provides 24-hour space at Alden library, which is considered their main library. The space offered is a second floor of the learning Commons. After midnight the access to other six floors of the library (both through stairway and elevator) is curtailed. Building passes are issued to the graduate students and faculty if they need to access other floors of the Alden Library; staff members can retrieve books for the undergraduate students when needed. Similarly, University of Delaware has a space, Morris Learning Commons, which is a part of the Morris Library, and is open 24/7/365, while Morris library itself is open until 2am Monday through Thursday.

University of California at Riverside offers 24-hour services only during finals and during the tenth week (quarter system) at the Orbach Science Library, one of the branch libraries. The main library is open until 2 am during that time.

Other libraries offer extended hours of service that are mostly offered on weekdays. For example, Morris Library at Southern Illinois University at Carbondale closes at midnight Sunday through Thursday; while similarly, the Babbidge Library at the University of Connecticut at Storrs is open Monday through Thursday from 7:30 am until 2 am.

Services offered during extended hours

Some libraries either offer abbreviated circulation services or skip it altogether. UC Riverside, however, provides most of usual services except for reserves and technical help. Some libraries use the extended hours to fill the ILL requests.

Reference and technical help

Most of the libraries do not offer reference assistance during night hours, but it is often provided via chat services. Ohio University offers reference and technical help along with the circulation services, copying and printing.

Security

For the most part, the libraries rely on their staff or students to keep an eye on the order; however some libraries either employ security or heavily rely on the University police department. For example, UC Riverside has a Security department that consists of 2 security personnel and 14 students patrolling the building. Cost of hire is divided with the student association. At the University of Delaware Morris library, after midnight the building is patrolled by the police department and students assistants from the University Police Department.

Problems:

- Maintaining clean library. At UC Riverside the library had to hire more custodial staff to maintain clean premises.
- Security issues. Ohio University library had problems with the community members who tried
 to live in the library. Police were called to assist and suggested to install the card-only
 entrance, which was later implemented.
- Staffing: Staffing was cited as one of major difficulties to plan for and implement the extended hours, especially 24-hours. In many instances institutions employed students to work during the extended hours, and as a result of that, some were considering creating a full time professional position in order to shift the duties.

Summary

Institutions that were studied, in fact, were different in size and their origin. Some were private and some were public; some libraries offer just a working space with computers and desks, and some keep entire library buildings open. Every library was working to provide an optimal amount of services according to their needs and possibilities. A few libraries provide 24 hours space, some for an entire week, and some for the part of the week, either Sunday through Thursday or Friday. Other institutions provide at least extended hours during the regular semester and during summer. During the extended hours the libraries stay open until midnight or 2am, which are shorter than the extended hours offered at the UAlbany main library (until 3am).

Technology and related services: For most libraries technology is typically provided by another department, similar to UAlbany's ITS department, and a working relationship exists between such department and the library. Some libraries were able to have technical help during all extended hours, including night, but usually it was not a frequent occurrence; most of the libraries did not provide technical help after midnight or 2 am.

General observation: the libraries contacted are constantly seeking improvements to their services offered at any given time, and the reflections provided in this overview might not hold true in a year or so.

Current Building Use & Trends

Overview

The task force sought to corroborate survey response data with facilities use data by performing observational studies in all three libraries. The task force gathered people counts in each library at predetermined times to accomplish this. Access Services and Dewey Library staff members went through each building counting the number of library users at specific times following building opening, during the afternoon, in the evening, and prior to closing. The task force was able to compare facilities use and demand around opening and closing to other times during the day to determine the need and potential use for earlier opening times and later closing times in each library. Data were not gathered for all hours of operation, but provide a snapshot of facilities use and demand. Data collection times were selected based on information gathered during previous data collection initiatives completed by the Access Services Department. In past years, the Access Services Department completed hourly people counts in the University and Science Libraries to gauge demand on facilities and library services. The department has since identified high-, average-, and low-use times in the University and Science Library. Known High- and average-use hours were selected for data gathering in this study.

Data Collection and Analysis

See Appendix D: "Data tables from Observational Studies"

The task force identified one to two-week periods during the calendar year to perform people counts to determine demand on library facilities during the academic semester, during intersessions, and during summer sessions. Floor count data was collected during for the week of May intersession (5/16/16-5/20/16), one week during the summer (7/18/16-7/24/16), the week of August Intersession (8/22/16-8/26/16), and 2 weeks during the Fall semester (the last week of the University Library closing at midnight: 9/18/16-9/24/16 and first week of the University Library closing at 3am: 9/25/16-10/2/2016). Sample statistics were gathered during these weeks because they represent the times library users have requested additional hours. By conducting floor counts during these selected weeks the task force was able to develop a better understanding of how many people were in the buildings and how they were using the facilities.

Library staff members and student employees walked around each building at designated times during the designated weeks with a floor map of the building containing a list of three activities—individual study, group study and PC use—and counted the number people on each floor engaged in each of these activities.

Research Questions

The task force sought to answer the following questions with the people count data gathered:

- Do the data indicate that we should provide more hours than we currently offer for any/all of our three Libraries?
- When is each library most heavily used?
- Which spaces in each library are most heavily used?
- Which dates around opening and closing are each library most heavily used?
- When is each library most heavily used and least used during intersessions?

Results & Discussion

The task force compared facility use immediately after opening and immediately prior to closing to the average facility use for each period, and looked for spikes in use at these times, to determine if the University Libraries should consider expanding hours in any of the three libraries.

The data indicated the need to consider expanding the Dewey Library's hours to remain open later during the May intersession and on Sundays during the academic semester. In both cases the average number of users in the Dewey Library prior to closing exceeded the overall daily average users; the observational count taken before closing was also the Dewey Library's peak usage at these times. The University and Science Libraries did not see large numbers of users immediately after opening or immediately prior to closing at any time. Peak usage occurs earlier in the day at each of these libraries and is extremely low around opening and closing times. Therefore, the task force found that operational hours for the University and Science Libraries are adequate given current use and demand.

Each library saw its heaviest use during the academic semester. All three libraries saw the heaviest use in the early evening (i.e., 5:00pm) during late-September. The Dewey Library was busiest on Sundays during the fall semester; the Science and University Libraries were busiest on Mondays during the fall semester; all three libraries see the most use in the late-afternoon to early-evening on these days.

The three University Libraries provide a variety of user spaces in each facility and created various noise-level zones at the beginning of the Fall 2015 semester. In examining the building use for each library, the task force determined the spaces and types of activities in which most users engage in each library. In the University Library, the first floor is the most heavily used space, with most users engaged in independent study. In the Science Library, the first floor Information Commons is the most heavily used space, with most users engaged in PC use. In the Dewey Library, the first floor is the most heavily used space, with most users engaged in PC use.

Each library saw the highest use around opening and closing during the fall semester from late-September to early-October. The University Library had 442 people using the facility within the first 2 hours of opening on Tuesday, September 20, and it had 433 people using the facility within the last hour of operation on Tuesday, September 27. The Dewey Library had 31 people using the facility within the first 2 hours of opening on Sunday, October 2, and it had 21 people using the facility within the last hour of operation on Monday, September 26. The Science Library had 136 people using the facility within the first 2 hours of opening on Monday, September 19, and it had 56 people using the facility within the last hour of operation on Wednesday, September 28.

Each library saw low usage during the May intersession with user counts as low as 14 people in the Dewey Library at 1pm on Monday, May 16, 36 people in the University Library on Thursday, May 19, and 23 people in the Science Library on Wednesday, May 18. Heaviest intersession use occurred just prior to the fall semester in each library with maximum user counts at 16 people in the Dewey Library at 1pm on Thursday, August 25; 131 people in the University Library at 1pm on Tuesday, August 23; and 62 people in the Science Library at 1pm on Tuesday, August 23.

Based on these data gathered, the task force found that the University Libraries hours adequately meet our users' needs. Overall, the task force does not support expanding hours; however, it is recommended that the Dewey Library trial a slightly later closing time during the May intersession and on Sundays during the academic semester.

Extended Hours and 24/7 Study Space

Extended Hours

- The Libraries extended hours for final exams largely meet student needs.
- Currently, during extended hours for final exams UPD has been posting a guard in the University Library Monday – Friday from 11pm until early morning, approximately 7 am. UPD

has not charged for this service. According to Aron Mull, Deputy Chief of Police – Operations, if the hours were expanded to remain open 24 hours on weekends they would be able to continue the free service.

- Weekend exams were introduced during the fall 2016 semester with no notification to the
 University Libraries. It must be investigated to determine if this will be a regular or an infrequent
 occurrence. During the fall weekend exam experience, it was difficult to get students out of the
 building at closing time. Weekend exams are scheduled intermittently based on the length of
 semester and exam demand. Coordination with the Registrar should be established to
 anticipate weekend exams.
- Collaborative, quiet study, Wi-Fi and PC use are the most heavily used resources based on observational data and user survey responses. Library services (borrowing books and equipment, research & technical help, etc.) were not heavily desired.
- Access Services has experienced difficulty recruiting staff and students to work until 3 a.m.
- The campus is not a convenient place to be at these hours: late night/early morning parking
 accommodations have become more restrictive and there are personal safety concerns of
 students traveling on campus at these hours, such as lack of exterior lighting.
- Bus service is not available which negatively impacts off-campus students both as users of Library services and potential library student assistants.

24/7 Study Space

There are no easy solutions for providing a 24/7 study space given the facility limitations that exist. Dewey Library should not be considered for providing 24/7 access due to its geographic location and because it is not a priority for the downtown population. The most efficient location for a 24/7 study space is a space that can be physically separated from the rest of the library with its own entrance. A 24/7 space <u>must</u> allow access to wheelchair users and differently abled individuals and there <u>must</u> be bathroom facilities included in the space. Currently, neither the University Library nor the Science Library has a space that can reasonably be closed off from the rest of the building or meet the access requirement.

The task force does not recommend providing 24/7 due to the following issues:

- Providing 24/7 study space would be far more economical if it was located elsewhere on campus.
- It would require a substantial amount of funding (easily \$500,000) to convert existing space in the University Library to a self-contained room that would provide bathrooms and ADA compliant access.
- The building would require modifications of all points of egress to segregate the 24/7 space from the rest of the building. For example, to create a 24/7 space in the Atrium of the Science Library Facilities estimated it would cost \$115,000 per floor in the Science Library to "lock" off the Atrium from the rest of the building.
- Keeping an entire building open will have substantial personnel costs and there are concerns about staff safety if a large space is minimally staffed. If the library staff covered this shift it would cost approximately \$45,000/year for one FTE and \$22/hour for two student assistants (\$11/hour for each student assistant). Deputy Chief Mull informed the task force UPD would either have to charge for providing this service or would need approval to expend and absorb the cost in their budget for the overtime. The current average UPD overtime rate (and they only charge University groups when the coverage necessitates OT) is about \$36/hour. UPD typically charges the actual cost so the invoices reflect who actually worked at the specific officer's hourly rate, not a set rate. Deputy Chief Mull is going to provide a cost for hiring an outside security firm to provide this type of service.

- University Library options: Locking off all the floors of the building except the first floor could be considered however the bathroom facilities on the first floor are very limited and not ADA compliant. Access to the basement level bathrooms would have to be allowed which would increase the cost of the necessary facilities modification. The building is almost impossible to section off the many ways users can communicate between floors, especially the emergency stairwells which need to provide egress at all times. Once a user is inside the emergency stairwell they can travel to any floor.
- Science Library options: Convert the Atrium to 24/7 study space as it has bathrooms available. This would require all the doors & stairwells to be locked off, roughly \$115,000/floor, and a security gate to prevent access to the elevators. Staffing could be limited to security guards.
- Access Services is already experiencing difficulty recruiting staff and students to work until 3am and it is anticipated that finding staff to work later would be even more difficult.
- The campus is not a convenient place to be at these hours: late night/early morning parking
 accommodations have become more restrictive and there are personal safety concerns of
 students traveling on campus at these hours, such as lack of exterior lighting.
- Prior experience with using security personnel to supervise late night library hours has been unsuccessful and it is recommended that this type of supervision of an entire building not be used.
- The Library Hours Survey indicates that 28% of respondents declared they would never use 24/7 study space. 22% would use this type of space 3 or more times per week, see Appendix A Library Survey Results, Q11 for other responses.
- Some of our peer institutions provide various types of 24/7 service: See the section on "Peer Institutions Comparison". Most of our peer institutions who provide this type of service either have a space that is self-contained or exists in a building that is easy to close off from the rest of the building, can be supervised by few staff members, and does not pose safety considerations due to lack of supervision. Most provide computers & Wi-Fi access while others are bare bones operations basically providing study space that varies from institution to institution.
- The University Libraries would have to employ staff that work different shifts: day, night, overnight, weekends, etc. See the section on "Staffing".
- This would also impact custodial services requiring an increase in staffing during the hours the building is open. This cost would most likely have to be funded by the library.
- In addition some type of security presence would be necessary, See the section on "Safety & security issues".

Staffing

Access Services and Dewey Library staff the three Libraries with a minimum of three staff members—one professional or clerical staff member and two student employees—for all hours that these buildings are open. This allows staff to operate buildings safely and effectively, providing service at the circulation desks, ensuring the facility is safe, and leaving service desks to assist users throughout the buildings.

The Libraries will need to hire extra staff members or contract with UPD, as well as allocate additional temporary services funding, if hours are expanded in a way that cannot be accommodated by shifting existing staff schedules.

Safety & Security Issues

Late night hours are not supported by the rest of the campus. Late night parking accommodations

have become more restrictive and there are personal safety concerns of students traveling on campus at these hours. Bus service is not available which negatively impacts off-campus students both as users of Library services and potential library student assistants. It is becoming more difficult recruiting staff and students to work late hours.

Currently, during extended hours for final exams UPD has been posting Security Service Assistants (SSA) in the University Library Monday – Friday from 11pm until early morning, approximately 7 am. SSA's are uniformed, unarmed assistants with walkie/talkies that serve as the "eyes and ears" of UPD and are responsible to relay any unusual activity they observe to dispatch police assistance when needed. While on duty in the library they will inform and enforce library policies with users. To date UPD has not charged for this service. According to Aron Mull, Deputy Chief of Police for Operations, if the hours were expanded to remain open 24 hours on weekends during extended hours they would be able to continue the free service. In addition the library would need to provide two student assistants to work during these hours.

Campus Resources for Study Space

There is very limited study space on the uptown campus and the options that do exist are not very flexible. The Campus Center has very limited study space and it doesn't appear that there are any plans to increase this type of space. The Commuter Lounge provides some space until midnight Monday - Saturday and until 10:00 pm on Sundays. The new east extension dining area has potential as a study space but it won't be a quiet space as it has a large screen TV and Sunday night football will be a priority in that space.

According to Todd Jones, Assistant Director of Facilities for Residential Life, the following study space options are offered by Residential Life:


- There are lounges in most of the low rise residential buildings in the basement of the buildings and there are some located on the second floors. The tower penthouses also offer study space. Alumni Quad also has study lounges in Waterbury Hall on the 2nd & 3rd floors & Pierce Hall on the 1st floor.
- All the study spaces are limited in use to on-campus students only. All on-campus students have swipe access to any building on campus until 11 pm. After 11 pm only students who reside in the building can enter the building. The low rise study lounges can be used until 11 pm by any on-campus student but only building residents can use the lounge after 11 pm. Students are able to use the study lounge all night long. The penthouse study spaces are open until 11 pm and are supervised by student assistants due to vandalism problems. Residents cannot use penthouse study spaces after 11 pm.
- Study lounges have movable tables and chairs, lounge furniture, and they are starting to add whiteboards. As they renovate buildings they upgrade the lounges to provide these amenities. They do not offer any technology in these spaces.
- Students residing on campus have late night space they can use to study without leaving their dorms. However, off-campus and graduate students do not have a place to go other than the library.

The Business School has eight group study rooms that are available to any student on campus and they are very popular. The rooms can only be used when the building is open but not past 11 pm. The building is closed on weekends but they are considering keeping it open in 2017. The Standish

Living Room is a large open space that students use as study space as well as a gathering spot for socializing. There are 3 MBA accounting labs and a trading room that students in the program are authorized to use and receive SUNYCard access to the rooms. The school does not give these students SUNYCard swipe access to the building but students stay in the building after closing to use this space which is very problematic.



Q8 Are there issues that present difficulties to visiting the libraries?





Q12 Which library would you perfer for 24 hour study space?



Q13 What services would you use if the Libraries could provide a 24 hours space? (select all that apply)





Q15 Do you find it inconvenient when the library is closed on the weekends during intersessions?



Q16 During intersessions what weekend hours would you perfer? (select all that apply)




